3. How have you made Irvine Football better?

- **Resume**

Include your GPA, sports played, other club activities, volunteer experience, work experience and any other important interests.

- **Transcripts**

- **Coach/Teacher Recommendation**

This letter should be from a coach or teacher who knows you well and it should address your character and work ethic as they relate to the Irvine Football core values. It cannot be from the head coach.

- **Teammate Recommendation**

Describe the applicant as a team-member and competitor. How has the applicant influenced Irvine Football in a positive way? How has he influenced you personally? The letter must be signed and dated.

- **Additional recommendation or comments (optional)**
